

**ORDER**

**SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O., 1990**

**ORDER NO. W-LL-F159/08 ONT**

The **MINING AND SURFACE RIGHTS** of the lands and lands under water described and shown on the attached plan as F159 (retained), are **WITHDRAWN** from prospecting, staking out, sale or lease in accordance with the terms of this Order.

These areas are withdrawn in preparation to be regulated as provincial parks or conservation reserves as approved in the Ontario's Living Legacy Land Use Strategy.

Saving, excepting and reserving hereto and herefrom all other lands patented, sold, leased staked out or otherwise alienated by the Crown at the date of this Order.

Any alienated lands lying within the limits of these withdrawn areas that revert to the Crown subsequent to the date of this Order will automatically be considered to be withdrawn as part of this Order.

This Order comes into effect on Saturday, January 12, 2008 at 12:01:01 a.m.

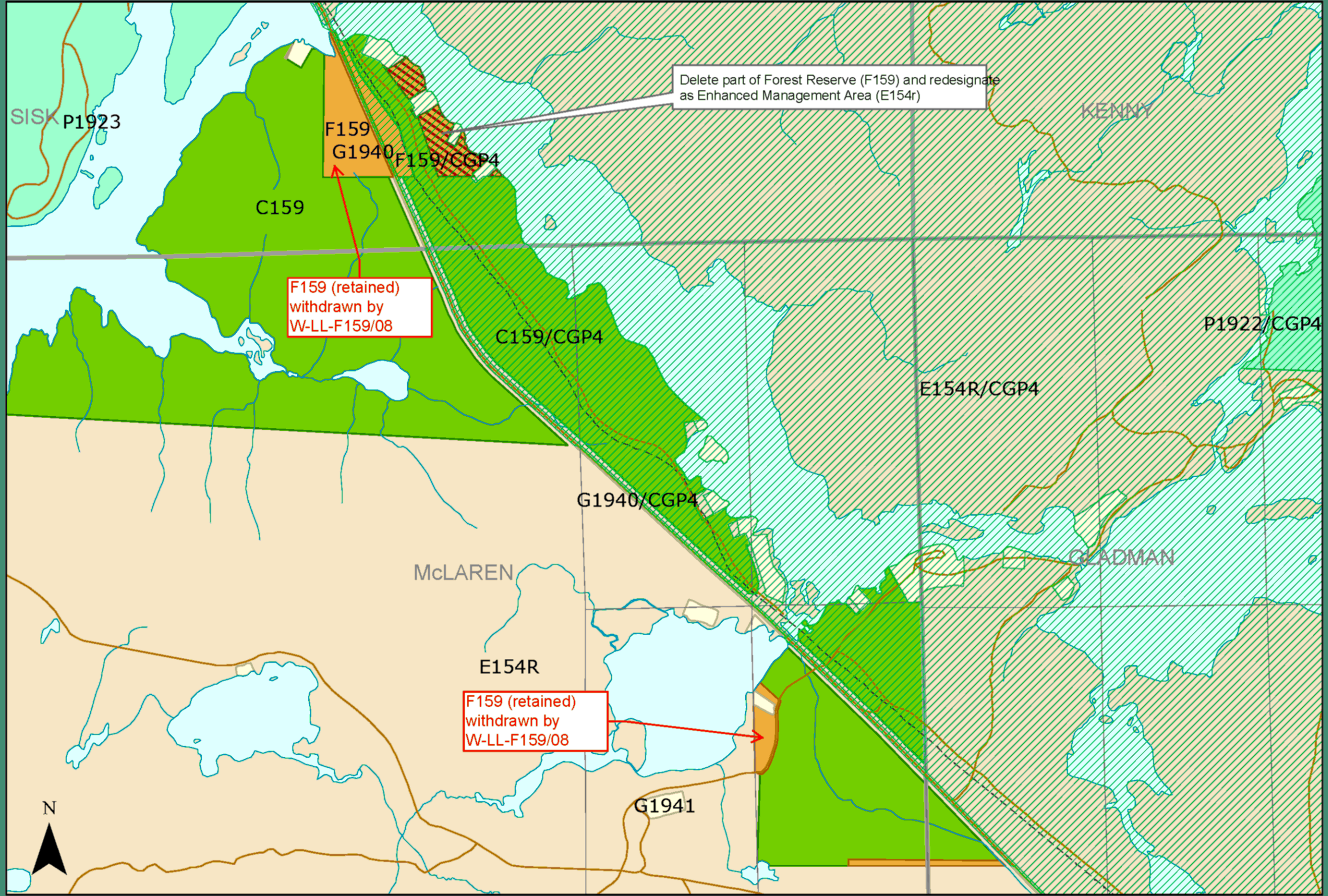
